



## TERMS & CONDITIONS

ORA Award is a free theme call. It is open to all artists regardless of age, nationality or any other qualification. Artists working with any media and technique can apply.

The main purpose of the ORA Award is to facilitate the start of new collaborations between emerging and mid-career artists and Italian galleries scattered throughout the national territory.

The jury of the ORA Award is made up of a variable number of galleries every year, and is presided over by a curator as President of the Jury. The 2019 edition of the ORA Award is the eighth edition of the Award, includes 10 galleries, and is chaired by curator Eva Comuzzi.

The galleries in the jury will evaluate each profile impartially and autonomously in order to select artists with whom they have never collaborated before.

Each gallery will select an artist to start a collaboration (solo show, inclusion in a group show or other event) and a potentially continuous work relationship. Over the years, many ORA winning

artists have established long-term relationships with the galleries that have awarded them and are now active artists on the international scene.

This year for the first time, ORA will also present a group exhibition of artists selected by the President of the Jury. The curator Eva Comuzzi will indeed select 5 artists for an exhibition to be held at the Galleria Massimo De Luca, in Venice. All exhibitions and events will be held in the 2019-20 exhibition season.

Applications should be sent online via the application form on [www.premio-ora.it](http://www.premio-ora.it).

Artists can choose between two application modes.

The BASIC mode (€ 45 registration fee) allows one to upload 1 work and curriculum.

The PLUS mode (€ 75 registration fee) allows the upload of 3 images, curriculum vitae, and a pdf portfolio, which can include an unlimited number of images, texts, and projects.

The registration fee is paid through the application form. At the moment of submitting the form, a PayPal window will be displayed where the applicant can pay the selected fee via PayPal or credit card. The registration fee is not refundable.

While filling in the online application form artists will be asked to upload images and documents. The images uploaded should be indicative of the artist's journey and not necessarily the works that would be part of the events. Indeed, in case of selection, galleries and artists will communicate directly and independently to determine each aspect of the collaboration.

ORA does not intercede in the exhibitions or the general collaboration between galleries and artists in any way. Type of event(s), works, sales and every other aspect is decided between gallery and artist, in line with the purpose of the award to create professional and lasting collaborations and not just single events.

Unless agreed directly with the gallery, all production and shipping costs are the artist's responsibility.

Our team assists in the initial communications between galleries and artists to facilitate the beginning of the collaboration, but ORA takes no responsibility for the events and collaborations between galleries and artists.

The deadline for applications is 31 May 2019. ORA reserves the right to extend the deadline by a few weeks beyond the original deadline. The results of the selections will be announced online at [www.premio-ora.it](http://www.premio-ora.it).

Each artist holds all rights to the images and the submitted works, but allows ORA the right of reproduction, display, publication, translation and communication to the public, in any manner and without exception, for his/her own works and texts participating in the selection.

Each candidate expressly authorises ORA and its direct delegates to process personal data transmitted in accordance with the privacy law and the European Regulation (GDPR 2016/679).
